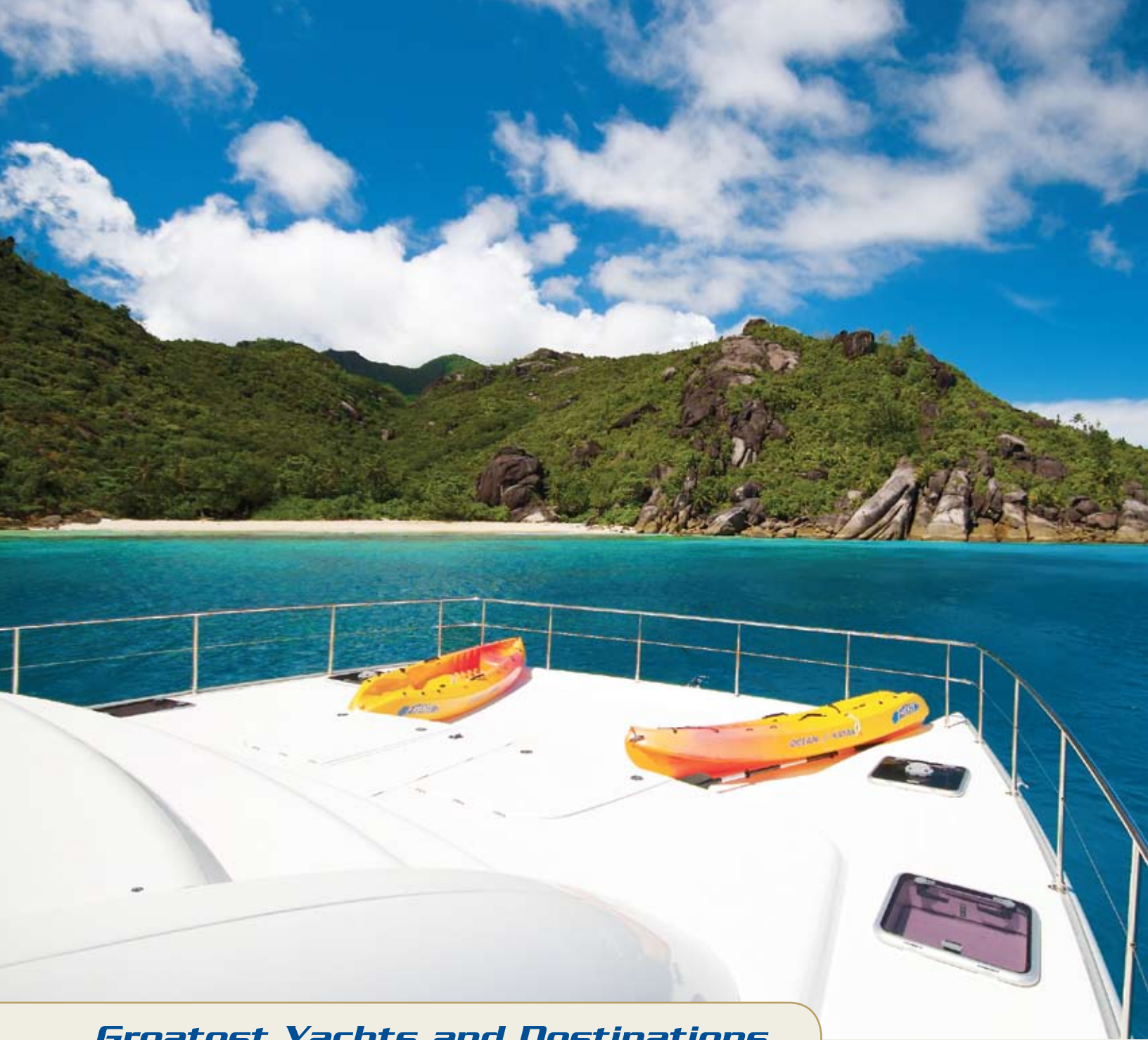

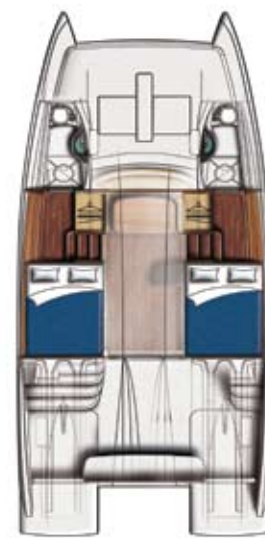

The comfortable and spacious cherry wood appointed cabins have large sidelight windows, hanging lockers, ample shelving storage areas, partial walk-around access to the double beds, and large en-suite lavatories with stall showers.

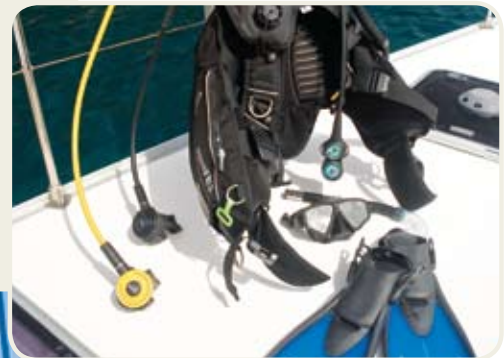

## ***Virgin Islands – The Caribbean***

The Moorings pioneered the charter industry in the British Virgin Islands over 40 years ago. There are so many reasons this cluster of around 30 unique islands offer the perfect vacation destination – stunning beauty, idyllic Caribbean islands, easy navigation, endless activities, and a reputation as the best cruising area in the world, are just a few.

From our recently remodeled Moorings Village on Tortola, the proximity of all the islands from Cruz Bay on St. John (US Virgin Islands) to Lower Soldier Bay on Virgin Gorda is only 32 nautical miles, with everything you could ever want contained in-between. Visit Jost Van Dyke, home to Foxy's famous watering hole, White Bay beach and the bubbly rock pools. On Virgin Gorda you'll find the Baths with towering granite boulders and winding pathways to protected tidal pools.

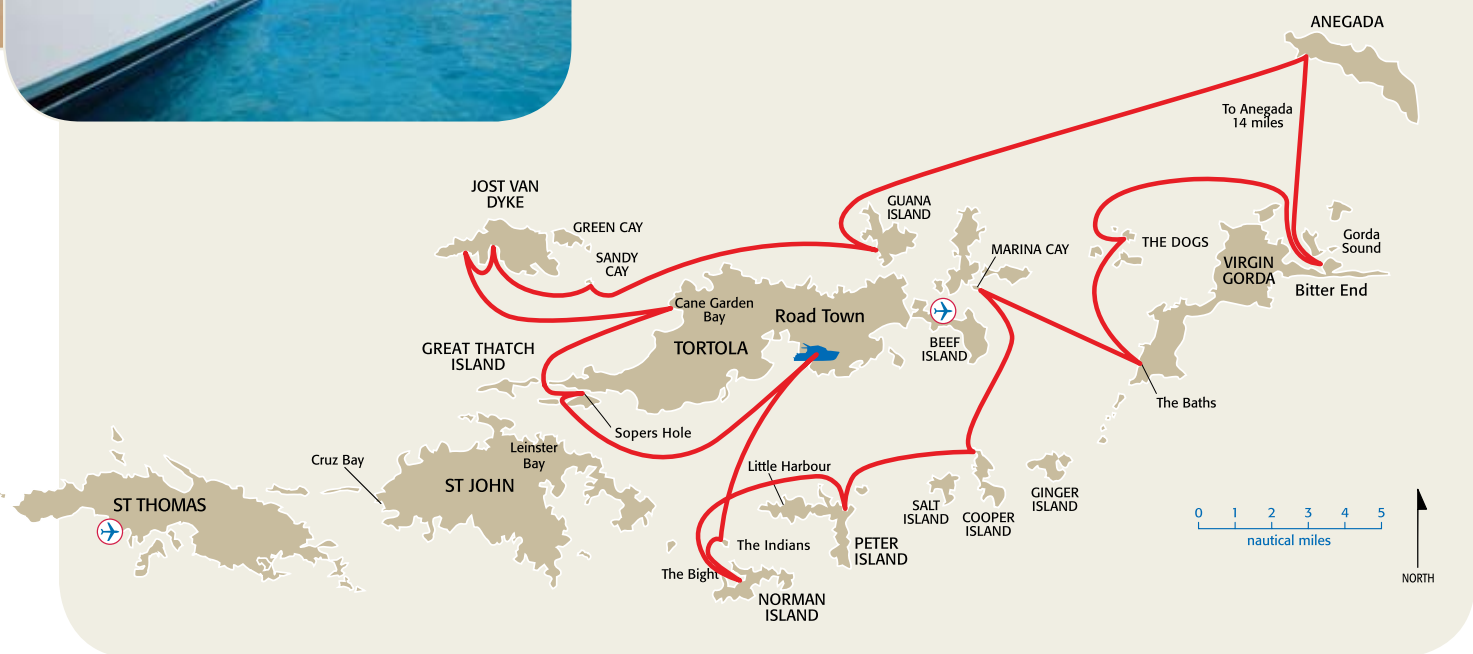
Further North, experience Gorda Sound, home of The Bitter End Yacht Club and Saba Rock where you can literally spend days in this idyllic location enjoying all the land and ocean-side activities. From Virgin Gorda, cruise one hour to reach the paradise of Anegada Island – home to pink flamingoes, a pristine 13 mile-long beach, and the Caribbean's best barbecued split lobster.

Once the favorite hangout of many famed pirates and privateers, today the British Virgin Islands still offers a treasure trove of activities and experiences for everybody.

This part of the Caribbean offers smooth, deep-water island hopping with simple line-of-sight navigation, so you always know where you're headed. During the day, you'll bask in beautiful sunshine with comfortable temperatures between 80° and 88° F; and best of all, by anchoring in a different location every night, you can enjoy an array of fine local cuisine and rustic bars.



- Day 1** Cruise from our base in Road Town, Tortola to The Bight at Norman Island. Along the way, stop-over at The Indians or The Caves to experience great snorkeling before heading on to your overnight anchorage. Dine under a star-studded sky aboard your yacht or on the "Willy T's" – a moored ship turned rousing bar.
- Day 2** Head up the Sir Francis Drake Channel to Peter Island and stop at Deadman's Bay for some great snorkeling. A bit further up the channel you'll find Cooper Island, with its pristine beach fringed with palm trees. Stop for lunch and a swim. From here, power over to Marina Cay for the night.
- Day 3** Power across to the amazing Baths. They call it "Stonehenge by the Sea" because of the enormous granite boulders lining the shore. Snorkel the crystal-clear waters and go ashore to explore the amazing rock formations. Then cruise up to Gorda Sound and spend the night anchored in one of many picturesque bays.
- Day 4** Try windsurfing in The Sound today, or snorkeling the extensive reefs off Eustacia Island. Visit the Bitter End Yacht Club, or the quaint shops and bars dotting the water's edge. Climb the footpath to the top of the hill at Virgin Gorda where you can enjoy stunning panoramic views of Gorda and Eustacia Sounds.
- Day 5** A beautiful 14-mile run will take you to the unique island of Anegada. Once anchored, take a taxi ride across to Loblolly Bay on the windward side of the island for more great snorkeling. Spend the afternoon relaxing and snorkeling in some of the clearest waters in the British Virgin Islands.
- Day 6** Depart Anegada and head southwest to Guana Island for a swim. Then, power over to the beautiful little island of Sandy Cay to enjoy some lunch off this quintessential small tropical island. Heading over to Jost Van Dyke where, you'll want to visit the world-famous Foxy's.
- Day 7** From Great Harbour, power around the corner to the beautiful white sandy beach at White Bay. Go for a swim and enjoy a cold drink at the Soggy Dollar Bar. Cruise across to Cane Garden Bay for lunch at one of the many beachside restaurants. Later, head down to Soper's Hole at West End for the night.
- Day 8** After breakfast, take a stroll and visit quaint waterfront shops before heading back to the base for a 10am hand-over.



Note: To reach the British Virgin Islands, you can fly directly in to Beef Island, or fly in to St. Thomas (U.S. Virgin islands) with an easy ferry ride to Tortola.





## ***Abacos - The Bahamas***

Easy air access from anywhere in North America makes this "the Caribbean that's close to home." From our facilities just 10 minutes from the Marsh Harbour airport, you will embark on a journey like none other. You will experience pristine secluded beaches, the beach at Treasure Cay is one of National Geographic's Top 10, commune with tropical fish among endless stretches of purple and yellow fan corals, and visit small settlements like Man-O-War Cay and Hope Town. Providing 100 miles of relaxed cruising, these relatively shallow and sheltered sandy bottom cruising grounds in this string of colorful cays are protected by the world's third largest barrier reef system.

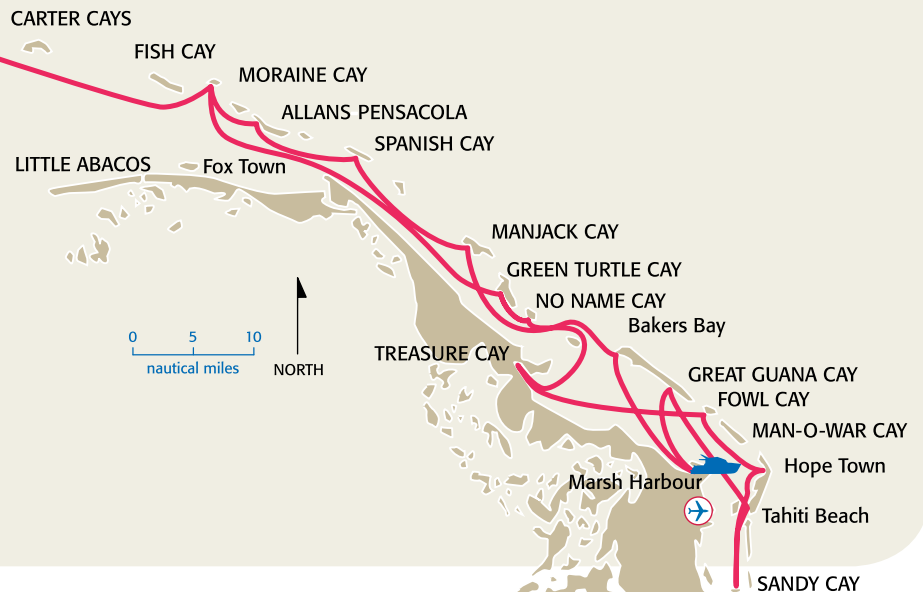
Great snorkeling and a Marine Park are the attractions at Fowl Cay. Cultural appeal is the calling card of Green Turtle Cay with its museum, sculpture gardens, and fine dining at the Green Turtle Club. Visible for miles is the historic lighthouse of Hope Town, a candy-striped sentinel on the southeastern reef. Head south to Pelican Cays' National Park where you'll be amazed by the vast collection of colorful coral and sea life.

Discover the Abacos — rich in sea-life for both viewing and dining delicacies, endless picturesque coves, and a laid-back attitude that's 100% Bahamian and a favorite among vacationers.



- Day 1** Depart for Bakers Bay, Great Guana Cay. This anchorage is surrounded by a gorgeous tree-lined beach. BBQ on board and witness a spectacular Abacos sunset.
- Day 2** A morning passage past Whale Cay offers the perfect opportunity to troll for Mahi Mahi. Drop anchor at Manjack Cay for lunch and snorkel the barrier reef. Then, it's on to Spanish Cay for the night. This out-island offers a full service marina, excellent restaurant and a beautiful white beach.
- Day 3** Power north for lunch at Allans-Pensacola Cay. Afterward, head farther north to the beautiful Moraine Cay and anchor off the picturesque beach for the night. This hidden anchorage offers good protection and great snorkeling. It's so secluded, you'll feel like you're at the very edge of civilization.
- Day 4** Head south to Green Turtle Cay. Pick up a mooring or pull into a slip at The Green Turtle Club. Visit the quaint village of New Plymouth with its historic sculpture gardens, art galleries and excellent local eateries.
- Day 5** Depart for No-Name Cay. The largest lobsters in The Abacos are found in the surrounding reefs. Lunch here before continuing on to Treasure Cay Resort and Marina, where the famous Spinnaker Restaurant, an 18-hole championship golf course and a beach rated one of the ten best in the world await you.
- Day 6** Cruise to Fowl Cay National Marine Park, a protected reef system offering amazing diving and snorkeling. Later, power past the candy-striped lighthouse and into Hope Town Harbor for the night. Enjoy a walk around the pastel colored village and select a place for dinner.
- Day 7** Next stop, Pelicans Cays. Snorkel Sandy Cay reef or settle down on the palm-shaded beach for an afternoon nap. Later, travel north into Lubbers Channel and drop the hook at Tahiti Beach. Afterward, head to Settlement Harbour on Great Guana Cay. Tonight, it's cocktails and dinner at Nipper's Beach Bar and Grill.
- Day 8** After breakfast and a morning swim, return to Marsh Harbour for a morning finish.

## ***Baja – The Sea of Cortez***

With over 5 million years in the making, the Baja peninsula and The Sea of Cortez is one of the youngest and richest ecosystems on our planet.

From our all-new resort facilities at Costa Baja Resort & Marina in the quaint and beautiful seaside town of La Paz, embark on an unforgettable journey like no other. Renowned for its bountiful fishing, here you will find yourself in awe as a pod of 5,000 dolphins pass you by, or as peace-loving whales come close by just to say hi!

On land, this desert brims with life, from the shore-side mangroves where you will encounter thousands of exotic birds, to small antelope herds. Walk through the 200 year old forests of Cardon cactai which tower 70 feet tall.

From wide open beaches, delicious cuisine, and small seaside villages of happy people, to the ever-changing kaleidoscopic colors of the landscape and the most magnificent sunsets you can see, there is something here for everyone. You'll also enjoy easy navigation, sand-bottom anchorages and a protected cruising area all year around. You are guaranteed exotic sea-life encounters with every visit to Baja, but for those who wish to see whales, plan to visit November through March.



Day 1

Board your yacht at 10:00am and cast off on a short 6 mile cruise to Caleta Lobos. In this well-protected anchorage, you'll start to relax as you enjoy some shallow water snorkeling among small coral formations and the ever changing colors of the rocky terrain.

Day 2

After breakfast depart for Los Islotes where you'll swim, snorkel and admire the sea lion colonies along the way. After lunch, make your way to the small beach and anchorage of Ensenada Grande with its pink volcanic cliffs—recently recognized as one of the most beautiful beaches in the world.

Day 3

Depart for the island of San Francisco—just 18 miles away. Here, you can explore the well known cactus forests, and the peace and serenity of a large lagoon, plus some incredible snorkeling sites where the sea is literally teeming with tropical fish.

Day 4

Depart for a leisurely 32 mile cruise to Puerto Gatos and admire the scenic coastline and bounty of sea-life along the way. If you enjoy fishing, this is an opportune time to catch a few grouper or tuna. Or you may run into Manuel—a local fisherman in the small anchorage of Puerto Gatos, who has fresh lobster and fish available most of the time.

Day 5

After enjoying breakfast in the picturesque anchorage of Puerto Gatos, power on to Candalleros point for some great snorkeling before arriving at Puerto Escondido for the evening. Here you can re-provision your yacht and possibly take a taxi to the town of Loreto to enjoy the streets and restaurants of this quaint and historic town.

Day 6

Power 24 miles back to Agua Verde where you can swim in the stunning turquoise waters and breathtaking scenery. Head over to Isla Santa Catalina to explore an awesome giant barrel cactus, and some great fishing on the northern and southern points of this island. Motor over to Punta Ballena for some great snorkeling, then over to San Evarista for the evening.

Day 7

Spend the morning in the area exploring the anchorages of San Jose and San Francisco, or motor 25 miles over to Caleta Lobos (a good first or last anchorage) where you can dine at the and Pichilique restaurant and scenic beach bar.

Day 8

Enjoy a leisurely swim before breakfast, and take in the breathtaking surroundings as you motor back to The Moorings base for a 10:00am departure.





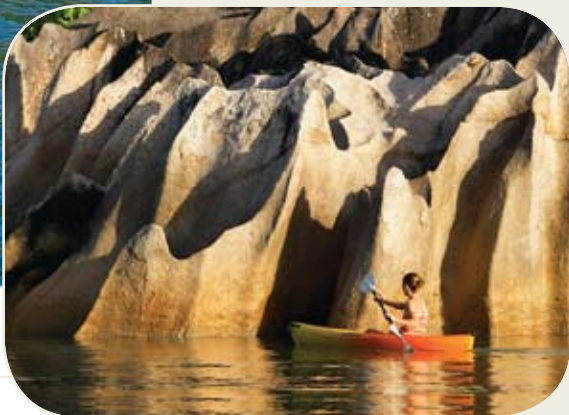


## ***Seychelles – The Indian Ocean***

The islands of the Seychelles are divided into six groups and offer an abundance of white sand beaches, bird and wildlife sanctuaries, and crystal-clear waters for premier snorkeling and incredible fishing and diving — but they especially offer an unspoiled destination perfect for a great vacation.

Begin your journey from Mahé, a port that offers a colorful backdrop with restaurants, a botanical garden, a natural history museum, art galleries and well-stocked markets. Here you'll discover an archipelago of 68 white sand beaches, cinnamon plantations, rainforests and lush vegetation.

Trolling en-route between these islands offers a seemingly endless supply of Tuna, Wahoo and other big game fish. The anchorages are composed of low-lying coral atolls or towering granite peaks, both of which offer pristine settings and isolated beauty. On land, the islands are home to birds, flowers, giant tortoises, reptiles and mammals that cannot be found anywhere else on earth. Just four degrees south of the Equator, these islands enjoy constant year-round air and water temperatures ranging from 80 to 86 degrees Fahrenheit. While the population is sparse, the Seychellois are friendly; and Creole, English and French are the official languages.



**Day 1**

Step aboard at 10am to start discovering the real beauty this destination has to offer. Power over to Beauvallon Bay on Mahé for the perfect anchorage, and discover the serenity and tranquility that will become part of your life for the next 7 days.

**Day 2**

Put your trolling lines in the water and power over to Praslin Island. Look to the starboard of "La Pointe des Chevaliers" to see Lazio Bay with its spectacular setting: a white sand beach lined with superb coconut trees. Consider stopping over for lunch. Enjoy your first snorkeling on the coral reef, then visit "Vallée de Mai," also known as the Garden of Eden.

**Day 3**

After a leisurely morning, stop at St. Pierre Islet for lunch and a swim. Here polished granite rocks, emerald green vegetation and sapphire water create a stunning picture. In Anse Volbert, this romantic landscape includes the famous "Coco d'Amour" or "Love Palm" tree.

**Day 4**

Hop over to Grand Soeur and visit the Islets Coco and Félicité—both picture perfect. The Soeurs' archipelago has a peculiar charm and because of its remoteness, is breathtakingly pristine. Before going ashore, jump in and watch the colorful schools of Damsel fish dancing over the coral reefs, or enjoy kayaking in this protected paradise.

**Day 5**

Power on to La Digue, with its huge natural granite sculptures. Here you will find numerous breathtaking anchorages to choose from.

**Day 6**

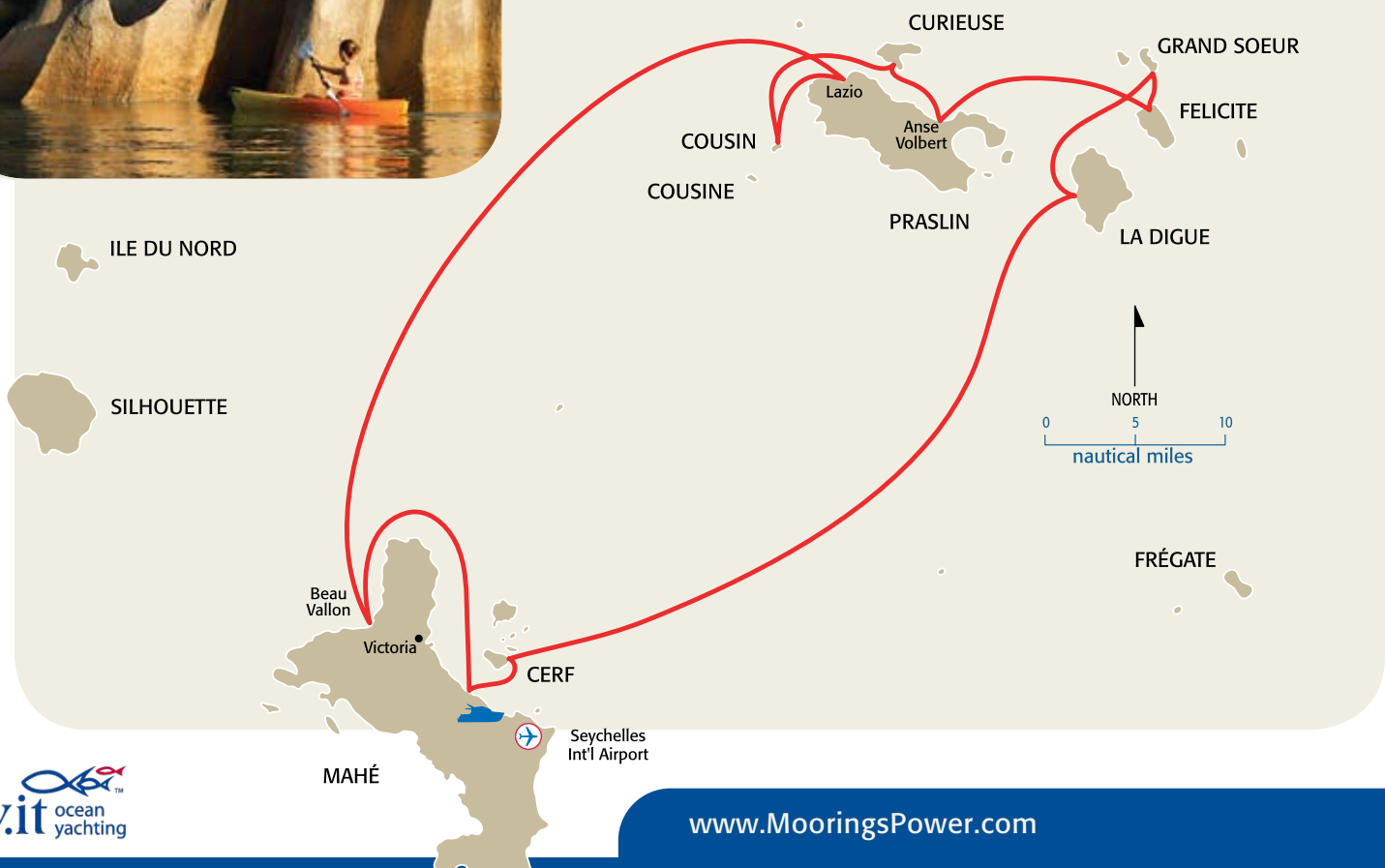
Another short cruise will take you to Cousin and Curieuse. These hilly and secluded islets are home to countless Seychelles gannets and frigate birds. Sail from North Cousin and head to Curieuse called the Red Island. Drop anchor in St. José Bay or in La Raie—another great snorkeling venue, before sitting down to another meal under the stars.

**Day 7**

Enjoy your tropical surroundings before a 4-hour cruise back towards Mahe, stopping for the evening at the underwater natural park of Ste Anne and Cerf Island. These lush islands remain untamed and provide great snorkeling in the brightly colored coral reefs, opportunity to kayak, and a lovely beach to walk at sunset.

**Day 8**

After breakfast, spend a few more hours enjoying Ste Anne and Cerf Islands before heading back to the Moorings base for a 10am departure.

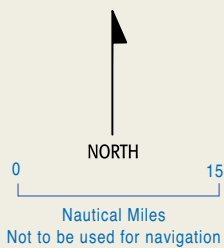
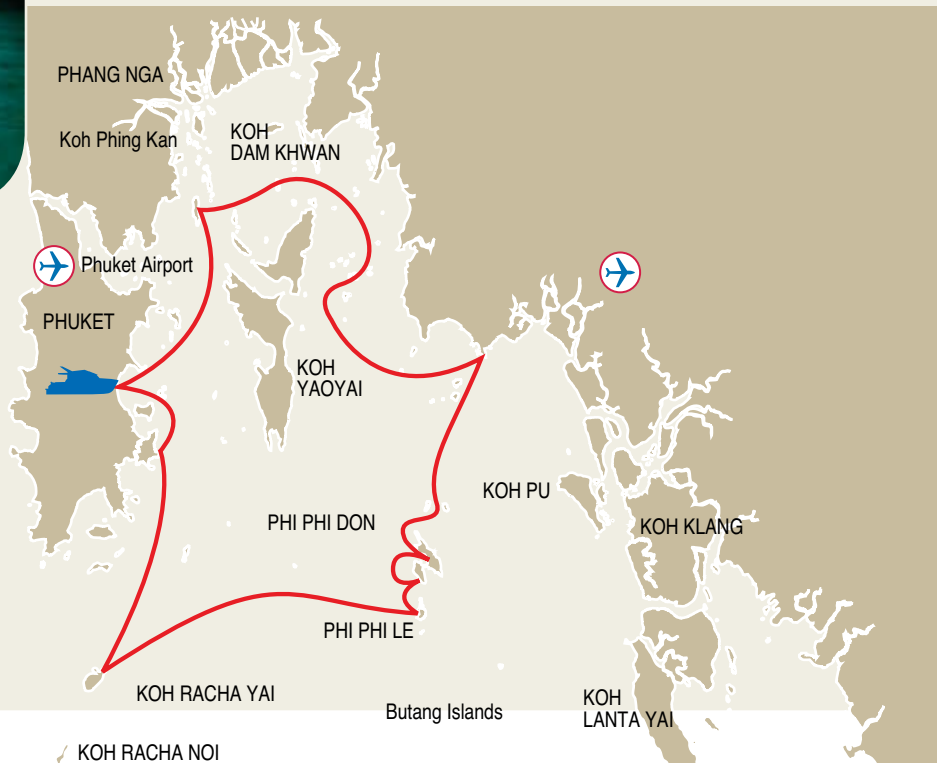

Nga Bay is also famous for the amazing towering limestone rock formations that rise vertically out of the calm turquoise waters, and “James Bond Island”.

Phi Phi Islands are a must with endless opportunities for snorkeling and swimming in the warm, protected waters of the Andaman. Snorkel the coral reefs teeming with undersea life, or climb one of the many limestone lookouts for stunning views. Visit Thailand for jaw dropping tropical beaches, wonderful people, and an incredible experience.



- Day 1** From our base in Ao Po Marina depart at 4:00pm heading north into Phang Nga Bay for Koh Hong. Enjoy exploring the hongs by kayak or dinghy. Overnight between towering limestone rocks.
- Day 2** After a leisurely breakfast and a morning swim, cruise through beautiful Phang Nga Bay admiring the scenery and islands, which include the world famous James Bond Island of Ko Tapu. Anchor at the quiet beach of Koh Hong Krabi with stunning white sandy beach, excellent coral, and a large lagoon to explore.
- Day 3** Cruise south down to the unspoiled area of Krabi, which has some of the most awe-inspiring scenery in the region, after exploring some of the outer island, overnight at Rai Le Beach, and enjoy many of the good restaurants and lively beach bars located here.
- Day 4** After a refreshing morning dip, make a beautiful crossing to the Phi Phi group of islands—renowned as some of the most beautiful in the world. Swim and snorkel in an abundance of colorful fish at Maya Bay, Phi Phi Le, the location for the film ‘The Beach’. Head to Tonsai Bay for the evening where you’ll find a lively village with bars and restaurants.
- Day 5** Spend the day exploring the islands around Phi Phi or just enjoying shopping and relaxing in the village.
- Day 6** Head west over to the beautiful island of Koh Racha Yai, this is another excellent snorkeling location, with more great restaurants and beach bars.
- Day 7** After a relaxing morning, head north towards Phuket, cruising through many of the small islands on route, lunch at Koh Khai Nok, where you may be lucky to see dolphins feeding on the coral. - Day 8** Pull up anchor by 8:00am for a short 10nm trip for a 9:00am arrival at the base.

- Day 8** Enjoy the scenery and reflect on this wonderful destination as you motor back to Hamilton Island. Disembark at 10am.

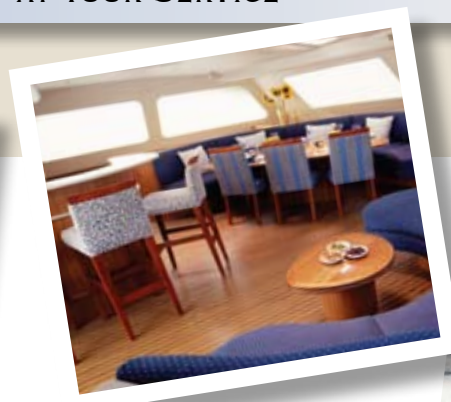
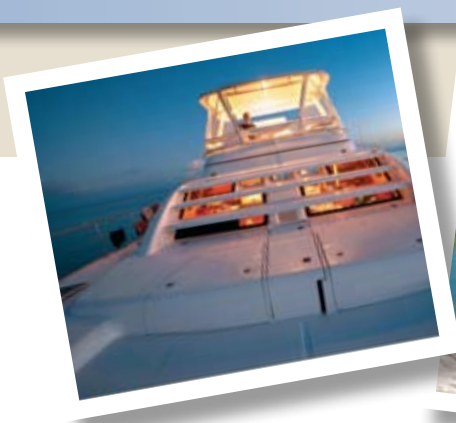

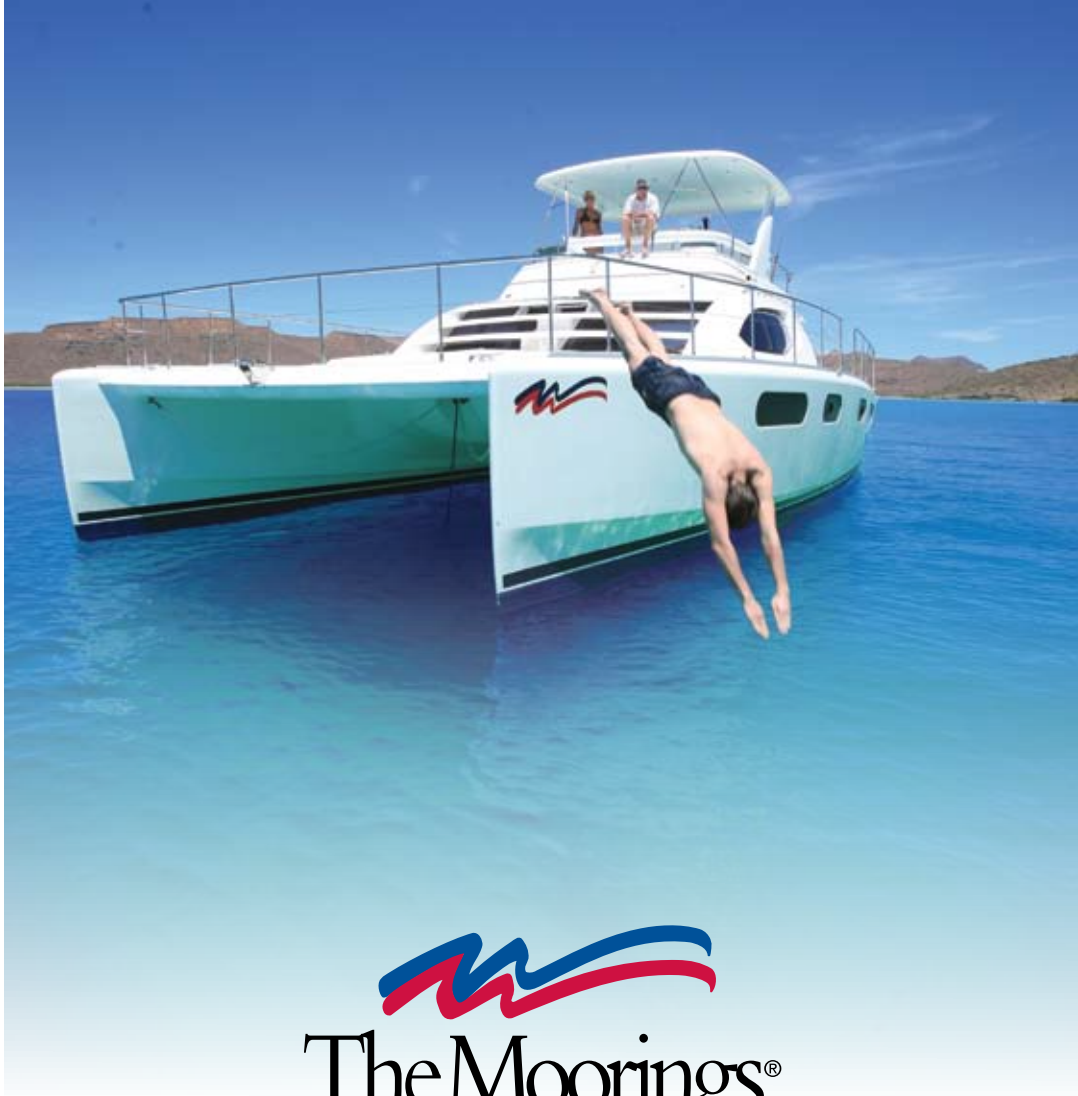
